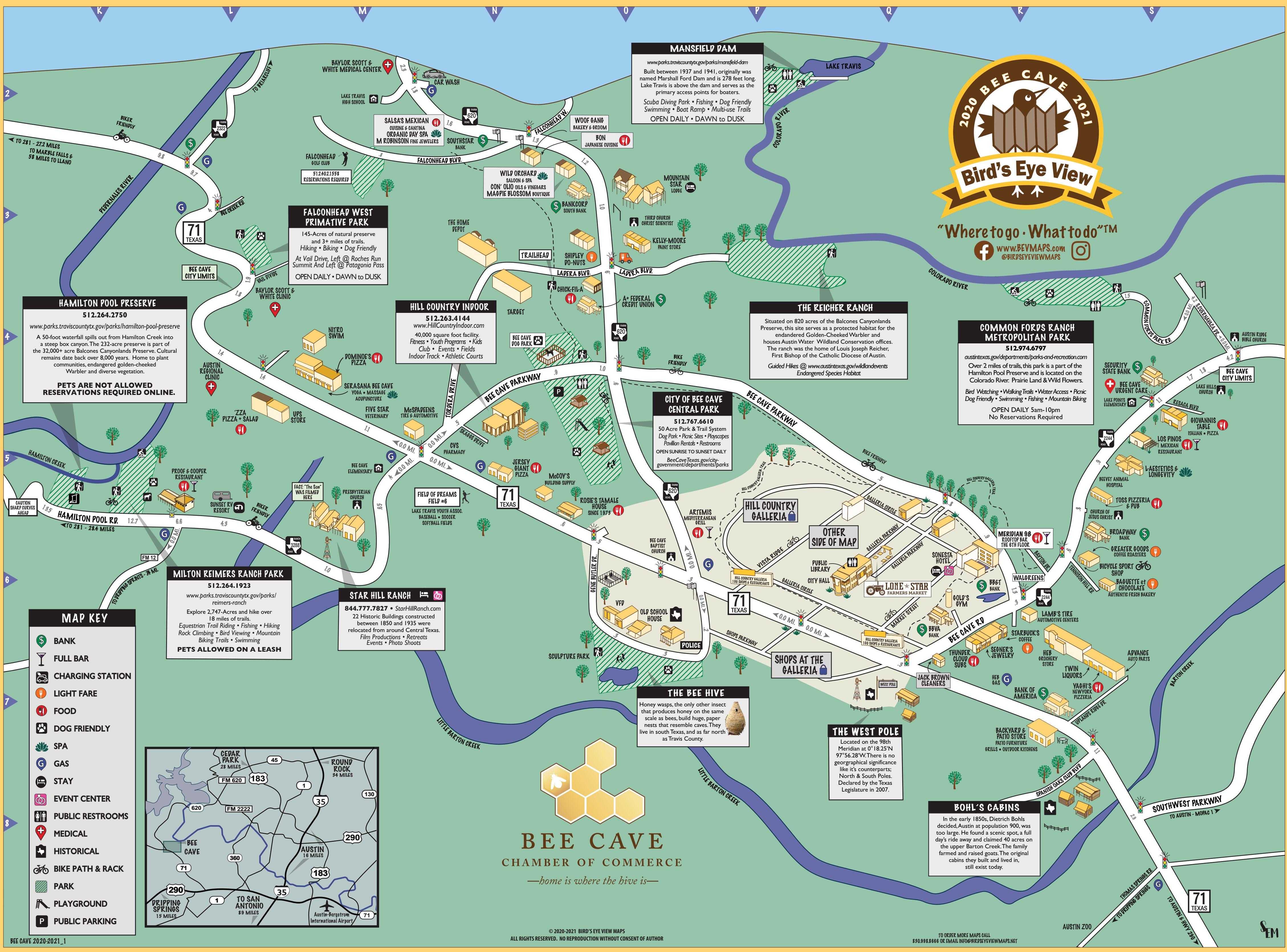

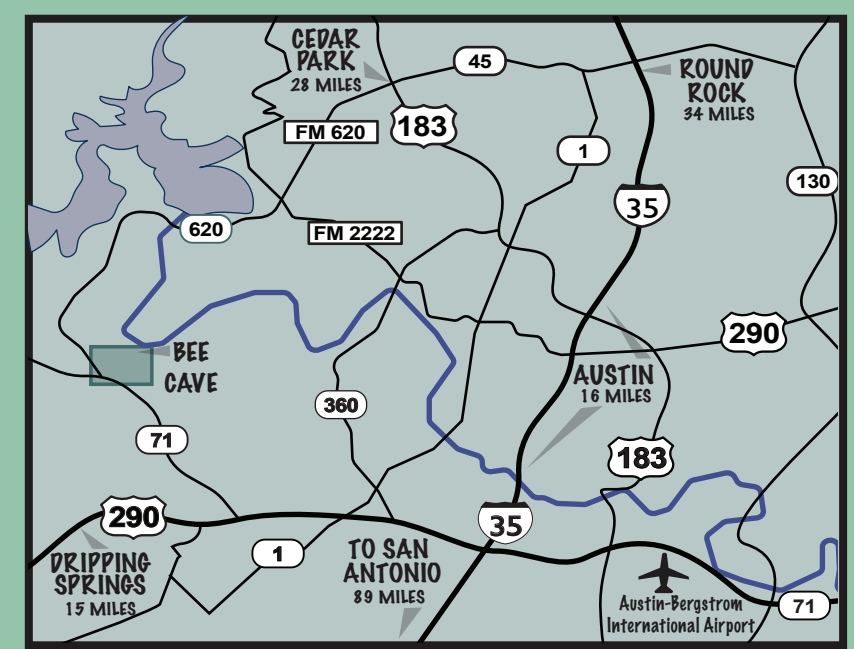

BOHL'S CABINS
In the early 1850s, Dietrich Bohls decided Austin at population 900, was too large. He found a scenic spot, a full day's ride away and claimed 40 acres on the upper Barton Creek. The family farmed and raised goats. The original cabins they built and lived in, still exist today.
